FROM THE PRESIDENT

Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong. Do everything in love. — 1 Corinthians 16:13-14

I can feel Spring right around the corner. Can you? Our ministry focus for 2025 is Be Strong, Be Courageous. It seems easier to be strong and courageous when we can get outside in warmer weather, enjoy God's creation, and visit with our neighbors. But, as Paul tells the Corinthians, stand firm in the faith, be courageous, be strong, do everything in Love all the time, not just when we can get outside in warmer weather. The Special Project for 2024-2025 will be wrapping up by June 30, 2025. Please send your donations to Becky Jones ABW-GRR Treasurer. Donations are going to Mini Libraries For Talita Cumi Girls Clubs — Goal: \$15,000. This project will provide 3,800 Spanish books of various reading levels at 50 Talita Cumi Girls Clubs in Costa Rica, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Mexico and Nicaragua. The goal of this project is to create 50 mini libraries in Latin America that will improve the literacy skills of girls in the Talita Cumi Girls Clubs and the chance for a better future. This project seeks to raise \$6,452 annually in order to create mini libraries with 3,800 Spanish



books of various reading levels.

Greetings from Ministries of Faith New Life, Azacualpa, Honduras 2/1/2025

In 2003, Dago and Dilia Zelaya started the Ministry along side FBC in Marshalltown,IA. Brenda, Alex and Mariana served as house parents to 23 children. Most of these children have graduated from our Ministry. Some are in college now and others have found jobs and live with family members in nearby cities or towns. Today, there are 5 children that live at the Ministry. The purpose of the Ministry is not to find new homes for any of these children but to raise them to lead productive and self-sufficient lives by the time they reach age 18 and leave the Home. All of the children help out with chores as any family member would. They help out with laundry, dishes, cleaning and helping with the cooking for the "family".

In early 2016 Dago decided to step down as the Director of Ministries of Faith. Dilia has taken up the director position and all other responsibilities that come with the Ministry. The campus includes a main house and two cottages where the director and house parents live. There is also a multipurpose building which is used as a church, cafeteria, clinic for medical teams, and large meeting room on the premises. You'll find the Vida Nueva Christian School there and a Guest house for visiting missionary teams. Additionally, the grounds house a school concessions stand, soccer field, playground, gardens and a gazebo.

The feeding program currently has 25 children enrolled from 1st grade to 6th grade. Monday-Friday we pick up the children from Brazil elementary school and bring them to



The Ministries of Faith campus for lunch. After they have lunch and play at our playground, we take them back to their neighborhood in our bus. Ministry


